### **Public Comments**

- Jeff Case Shared personal experiences with own school changing athletic leagues.
   Concern with the issue of changing/not changing.
- 2. Shawn Carr Shared that his family had moved away from and recently returned to Athens. Thinks something needs to change regarding the athletic league.
- 3. James Phillips Recent Athens graduate. Shared concerns over how athletes feel suffering losses. Wants to change conferences.
- 4. Lucy Lamson Shared concern over discussion focusing on boys athletics. Concern that some programs not making efforts to better their programs. Concerned with idea to change athletic conference.
- 5. Nathan Kieffer Shared concern with safety while athletes playing football with smaller team size (greater risk of injury, ect)
- 6. Becky Schroder Shared concern over whether a non-winning/non-successful sports program. Concern over boys' program being left behind/pushed aside.
- 7. Joscelyn Minier Shared that numbers are an issue for boys' and girls' programs. Lack of public/support for teams other than football.
- 8. Jefferey Williams Concern that numbers an issue for Athens compared to others. Wants kids to be able to compete.
- 9. Rick Schroder Explained the attached packet on other proposed league. Shared concern with Rocket Football program safety (age differences). Changing conferences will put us on a level playing field.
- 10. Sara Stanton It's a difficult decision. All won't be happy with the decision. Not a popularity contest between athletic programs.
